This year St. Francis Hospice Dublin will progress our plans for the construction of a new 24-bed in-patient unit to include new underground carpark and clinical support facilities with bridge links to existing St. Francis Hospice Raheny buildings. The additional rooms will enable us to keep pace with the growing needs and ageing population in the catchment area we serve.

It is our privilege to work so closely and collaboratively with community as we continue with our mission to provide the best quality specialist palliative care services for patients and families. We are deeply grateful to you for any support you can provide to ensure hospice service provision and development for the people of North Dublin city, county and its surrounding counties.

Annual Revenue

The Health Service Executive provide the hospice with funding of €16.17m. In 2023 we need to raise €4.5m to maintain our high quality palliative care services and to progress with major and minor projects at both hospices.
