Senior Occupational Therapist Permanent – 1 WTE, 37 hours per week (Blanchardstown /Raheny)

The Senior Occupational Therapist will be required to work as part of the Occupational Therapy team at St. Francis Hospice Dublin working across the different services (IPU, Out-patient and day services, and Community)

The post holder will be responsible for the delivery of first class Occupational Therapy services to patients with life-limiting conditions, working in close collaboration with other multi-disciplinary team members.

Essential Requirements:

- Be registered on the Occupational Therapists Register maintained by the Occupational Therapists Registration Board at CORU
- A minimum of 3 years full time (or equivalent) recent post graduate experience, 1 of which must have been in a hospice setting/ acute hospital setting and/ or primary care.
- High level of competency in completing functional and seating assessments
- Demonstrate expertise in complex discharge planning and risk assessment
- Candidates must demonstrate excellent organisational, leadership and communication skills
- Experience in the areas of service development and quality improvement initiatives
- Experience providing professional supervision
- Evidence of continuing professional development, relevant to palliative care
- Full driving licence

- Experience in symptom management education
