The Senior Occupational Therapist will be required to work as part of the Occupational Therapy team at St. Francis Hospice Dublin working across the different services (IPU, Out-patient and day services, and Community). The post holder will be responsible for the delivery of first class Occupational Therapy services to patients with life-limiting conditions, working in close collaboration with other multi-disciplinary team members.
